

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR JABRA PRODUCTS

Prolong the life of your products with these simple cleaning tips

DOs

- **Keep products clean** by avoiding contact with dirty surfaces. When not in use, dock your headset in its charging base, or store it in a case/pouch, to protect it from scratches and dust.
- Remember to clean your ear cushions or EarGels regularly, and replace them when they show signs of wear and tear, or in case of heavy usage.

DON'Ts

- Do not use any alcohol-based hand sanitizers (ethanol and isopropanol) or alcohol-based disinfectant wipes to clean your product. Doing so can risk damaging the surface of the product.
- Avoid using UV light sanitizing methods as they are not suitable for Jabra products. Doing so can risk damaging the surface of the product.
- If sharing your headsets with others, we do not recommend sharing ear cushions or boom-arm foam tips (if applicable).





HOW TO CLEAN YOUR JABRA PRODUCT

- Apply normal dish soap and water to a cloth, making sure to wring out any excess liquid so the cloth is not dripping wet. Use soap and water only; do not use strong cleaning agents.
- Gently wipe the product, making sure it is clean with no layer of suds on the surface.
- Let it rest for at least one minute.
- Rinse the surface by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth using water only.
- Allow the product to dry.
- For your charging case: Use a dry swab to gently clean the pins/charging contacts in the charging case. You can also use the dry swab to gently clean the poles/charging contacts on the earbuds.

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
